A man's low sperm count and decreased sperm motility can be due to a low level of zinc intake. Good sources for a healthy daily dose of 15 to 30mg of zinc are meats, fish, and whole grains. EGG DONOR PROGRAM AT IVF ORANGE

Egg Donation is a wonderful way for a young woman to help another woman to have a family. Due to popular demand, IVF-Orange has expanded its in-house egg donor program to make the application process for egg donor candidates easier. REPEAT IVF INCREASES SUCCESS

Math experts tell us that the chance of winning the lottery every week doesn't increase with time. It's the same probability every week to win the Jackpot when playing one ticket. This statistical fact, however, doesn't apply to the treatment of in-vitro-fertilization (IVF), as a recent study suggests. Researchers in Australia examined the IVF treatment history and live birth rates of over 8,200 women between the ages 20 and 44. They found that IVF was successful in 47% of all couples, who had on average 3 IVF cycles. By segmenting the women by age groups, the study found that the success of IVF increased with each successive cycle for the first 5 cycles for all age groups, but in particular for women under the age of 35.

So, despite advanced maternal age, your chances of having a baby with IVF might increase with a repeat IVF cycle, this study suggests.
